Jeff was a starting linebacker at Stanford University. He was latter inducted into the College Football Hall of Fame. After he graduated in 1972 he was

drafted in the first round by the Minnesota Vikings. During his ten year carrier he played in three Super Bowls and four Pro-Bowls and was named

Most Valuable Player by his teammates in 1978.

After his retirement from football he received a Masters degree of Christian Apologetics from the Simon Greenleaf



School of Law in Los Angeles CA in 1984.

Jeff is now the Division Director of Search Ministries Minnesota in Minneapolis. We look forward to hearing his witness.
